- Potholders and bags for Mission-Q were provided.
- Apple Cider and hot chocolate was given out for the Tuscumbia Christmas Parade.

- Reindeer bags for Cottage of the Shoals residents were delivered; and 15 residents were sponsored for Christmas.
- Complete Thanksgiving meals for the Sheffield Homeless carwash were provided.
- Christmas Joy baskets for the elderly were provided.
- We hosted a Master's t-shirt jump rope making party for a Waterloo youth group and leaders.
- Blankets, stuffed animals, and word search books were delivered Christmas Day for Keller Landing residents.
- Prayer pillowcases for those who were critically ill were delivered.
- Yarn and material for Woodmont Salvation Doll ministry were donated.

God not only provided these local mission opportunities, but, He also has provided amazingly for the ministry team. We were able to enlarge our work space by adding the adjacent room thanks to the Calvary men who worked so diligently to take down the wall and helped us move and organize the room.
